# The HORIZON 2020 context: Why SEWP? Main reasons for lower share & success rates of widening countries in FP

Commission's analysis (2011)	High Level Expert Group on the Ex-post evaluation of FP7 (2014), STOA reports (2018, 2020)
> Insufficient R&D investments	Relative weakness of national R&I system compared to advanced countries
Lack of synergies between certain countries' national research systems and EU research	<ul> <li>Uneven success rates across topics and instruments (e.g. higher in CSA, lower in ERC)</li> </ul>
Lagging system learning effects and access to existing networks	> Lack of professional contacts and research networks
Differential wage levels between countries	<ul> <li>Lack of leading research organisations and universities in proposal matters - lower quality of proposals</li> </ul>
Insufficient and ineffective information, communication, advice and training	> Quality and quantity of proposals
	Lack of practice in project management
	> Low connectivity to excellent research networks
	Generally weak linkages between academia and business
	> Few options for exploitation of research results at the national level

### Core actions: overall policy expectations

- TEAMING → light house project in national research system, contribute to reform processes
- TWINNING 

  development of excellence and research profile in a defined R&I field
- ERA CHAIRS → game changer in host organisation by excellent individual + his/her team
- COST → wide reaching networks as entry mechanism to EU research, 'leveraging' national R&I funding



## Twinning: Aim, Objectives & Partnership

#### Aim of the action:

Strengthen a defined field of research in a university or research organisation from a

**Widening country** by linking it with at least two internationally-leading research institutions in other Member States or Associated Countries.

#### **Main objectives:**

Enhance the **S&T capacity** of the institutions - focus on institution in Widening country Raise the research profile of the **institution and** of its research **staff** 

**The Partners:** (Minimum Conditions)

**ONE** institution located in a "Widening" MS/AC (**COORDINATOR**)

A minimum of TWO additional partners from two different MS or AC other than the country of the coordinator



#### Twinning: Expected impact

- Increased research excellence of coordinating institution, in particular, in the selected field of research enabling to close the still apparent research and innovation gap within Europe
- Improved capability to succeed in competitive research funding
- Enhanced reputation, attractiveness and networking
- The expected potential impact of the project illustrated by a number of indicators
- Benefit from/to "advanced" partners to be demonstrated
- Improved capacity to attract quality personnel and funding from other parts of the FP or other EC funding schemes




#### Twinning: Challenges and key success factors

- Wide range of possibilities offered by Twinning → make full use the Twinning tool-box
- Sustainability or how to maintain new networks beyond the end of the project → both partners ('advanced' and 'widening') should foresee a long term horizon for cooperation
- Focus on strengthening research management skills in the coordinating institution
